

PARLOR INFORMATION FOR N.S.G.W. SCHOLARSHIPS

PLEASE NOTE: In addition to the three Collegiate Scholarships, this year, there will be a Vocational Skills Scholarship in the amount of \$1200 added to the application form. Be sure the applicant checks the correct box on the application.

All materials and information regarding the NSGW Scholarship should be in the hands of individual NSGW parlors by **October 10th**. Each parlor is responsible for contacting the students with all information and forms for the scholarship by **November 1st**. (Must be a relative of the NSGW and born in California)

Materials sent to individual parlors include the following:

1. Student Applications and Information
2. School Information Form
3. Parlors may use NSGW Website (www.nsgw.org) to obtain all info and forms, if they so wish.
4. Parlors may make additional copies of any scholarship forms, if needed.

Check the list for the Area Chairperson and send all completed applications to that person.

Scholarship materials should be in the hands of the individual schools by **November 1st**. The request forms for the individual scholarships should be returned to area chairperson by **March 15th** in order for the committee to have time to select a winner.

AWARDS

1. 1st place recipient will receive \$2000.00 and the two runner-ups will receive \$1000.00 each for the Collegiate Scholarship.
2. Vocational Skills Scholarship of \$1200.00 will be awarded to the winner.
3. Winners will be announced at Grand Parlor and award winners will be informed by Grand Parlor.
4. Parlor delegates will notify respective parlor of scholarship winners.
5. Funds will be sent to either the Vocational or Collegiate Institution upon proof of acceptance.

The Native Sons of the Golden West Scholarship Foundation is awarding one \$2000.00 and two \$1000.00 merit-based grant awards to a California Junior or Senior high school student or enrolled in a California Junior College or a freshman in a 4-year institution of higher learning. There will also be a Vocational Skills Scholarship in the amount of \$1200 awarded. The scholarships will be awarded to a student who demonstrates achievements in academics, participation in school activities, leadership and personal development. The scholarship is awarded without regard to race, gender, age, physical abilities or financial status. Funds will be sent to institution of higher learning upon proof of acceptance. **Must be a relative of a Native Son of the Golden West or a Native Son.**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Be a Junior or Senior in a California high school or enrolled in a junior college or a freshman in a 4-year institution of higher learning.
2. Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 (C+ average)
3. Meet graduation requirements of that particular school
4. Must be a relative of a Native Son of the Golden West or a Native Son
5. Must be accepted in a school of higher education or a Vocational Skills institution and submit proof of acceptance
6. If attending a junior college or a freshman in college, must send transcript and SAT scores
7. Previous applicants may reapply if they meet all requirements

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Submit high school or junior college transcript and SAT scores
2. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation
 - a. Teacher or Counselor
 - b. Native Son connection
 - c. Leader in the community
 - d. Letter of support from the recommending NSGW Parlor
3. Complete, sign and submit completed application to one of Scholarship Committee members (see attached) by **MARCH 15**. Award selection will be made on **MAY 1**.
4. Monetary award will be sent to the Admission Office at the school of student's choice.
